#### **2021 SUMMER LEADERSHIP FORUM IS IN THE BOOKS**



Click <u>Change</u>, and on the next page select the Auto Renewal option and click NEXT. On the next page, click <u>UPDATE AND NEXT</u>. You will receive a confirmation screen. Follow the prompts to complete the change. Your credit card will be charged the applicable amount for your 2021-2022 dues.

In subsequent years you will receive a notice 14 days prior to September 1st, and your membership will automatically renew, and your card will be charged, on September 1st. You can always opt back out at any time.

The auto renewal option is available for both regular and retired members. Multi-Members, whose companies have 10 or more members will continue to be invoiced annually.
